Digital Millennium Copyright Act ("DMCA")

- d. Information reasonably sufficient to permit NIRA to contact you, such as an address, telephone number, and, if available, an electronic mail address at which you may be contacted;
- e. A statement that you have a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner or other intellectual property rights owner, its agent, or by law.
- f. A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are the owner or are authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.

NIRA may request additional information before removing any allegedly infringing material. In the event NIRA removes the allegedly infringing materials, NIRA will immediately notify the person responsible for posting such materials that NIRA removed or disabled access to the materials. NIRA may also provide the responsible person with your e-mail address so that the person may respond to your allegations.

NIRA reserves the right to terminate, limit or suspend any user's access to the Site in the event of repeated infringing activity. If you believe that a user of this Site is a repeat infringer, please follow the above instructions to contact the NIRA Copyright Agent. Please include sufficient information to assist NIRA in determining that the user repeatedly engaged in infringing activity.
